Registration and further information about the **SEALINK JUMP FOR THE JETTY** swim will take place at the Tobruk Pool, between 3.30pm and 4.30 pm Saturday 12 August. Because of the limit on the number of swimmers that can be carried onboard the vessel **prior registration is compulsory** for anyone wanting to swim.

The actual swim will be held on Sunday 13 August. Collection of caps and numbering will start at 10.45am at the Sealink terminal. Swimmers will board a special Sealink ferry departing at 11.35am with the final briefing conducted onboard the vessel. Swimmers will be carried and receive a return ticket as part of their entry fee and support from Sealink.

\$15 adult and \$10 children return tickets for spectators and supporters will be available for sale and transport on the normal 11.30 am ferry. This ferry will proceed to Nelly Bay where spectators will disembark and will need to buy a return or full day bus ticket to Picnic Bay. Excellent vantage points will be available on the Picnic Bay jetty.

The swimmers ferry will proceed to the edge of Picnic Bay (Hawkins Point). Swimmers will have a choice of a 1km or 2km swim. Wetsuit and Non-Wetsuit categories are available.

The 2km wave will start in the water at 12.20 and the 1km swim shortly after. Swimmers bags will be collected and taken to the beach. All swimmers will head towards a buoy near the end of the jetty and then around a series of buoys, back towards the beach. Swimmers should be finished by 1.15pm.

IRBs and other craft will provide water safety.

The Swim Series presentations will be conducted at Picnic Bay Surf Lifesaving Club on the Island shortly after the swim.

Swimmers and supporters will then be able to catch a bus to connect with either the 3pm or 4.25pm ferry back to Townsville or spend some more time exploring the island. You will have to buy your own bus ticket or enjoy a pleasant walk back to the Nelly Bay terminal.
